PURPOSE The Coyote Country Radio Scholarship Fund was established in 2017. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals that seek higher education in community colleges, technical schools, colleges and universities. Preference will be given to students who attended high school in Borden County.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on academic performance, leadership potential, and participation in extracurricular activities. Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Coyote Country Radio awards scholarships on the basis of a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include, but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Extracurricular Activity Involvement, Community Service, References, and Financial Need. Coyote Country Radio pays scholarship funds directly to the institution on behalf of applicant. Scholarships are awarded once per recipient. The Coyote Country Radio Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

- Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must be accepted as a student at a technical school, college or university for the upcoming academic semester. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant.

CRITERIA Continued.

- Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States.
- Preference will be given to students who attended high school in Borden County, Texas.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by **May 10**

TIMELINE

- Applications are due **May 10 of the current calendar year.**
- Candidates may be asked for an interview by the Scholarship Committee conducted in early May.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by May 20

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official proof of academic standing.
- A letter of academic references from a guidance counselor or teacher.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic school for post-secondary studies.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Awards will be given before the Fall Semester.
- Applicant must provide their **student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be used.**
